November is a great month for golf at Bear Creek Golf Club! There are no prebooked outings to limit tee time availability. Open play is less frequent. Reduced Cool Season Rates begin November 1st - call the Pro Shop for specifics. Online rates are reduced as well. Monday and Tuesday Senior Scrambles start at 9am, in the warmest part of the day, and then are followed by a complimentary lunch after golf.

Cool Season Online Tee Times

Online tee times at "bearcreekgolf.com" are always a great idea, but are even a better option in the Cool Season. From April-September, the pro shop is open to take telephone tee times for 15 hours a day from 6am-9pm. During the Cool Season, the number of hours available for phone reservations decreases significantly. However, "bearcreekgolf.com" is open 24/7/365 to accept your golf reservation at our lowest available rate for that day of the week and time of day!

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Preparing for Winter Weather

With temperatures dropping below freezing, there are a number of things we do to prepare the course. Water coolers are brought in and drinking fountains are turned off to avoid freezing. All the ball washers are taken in to the maintenance shed except for two on each nine. The washers left on the course are then filled with windshield wiper fluid to avoid freezing and cracking. The restrooms on the course have heaters that are turned on and the irrigation pump house gets a heater put in it as well. Due to the extreme heat put off by the pump motors and weather in the summer, all of the insulation in the ceiling is removed and stored. Now is the time that we get it back out and put it up. Finally, all the anti-freeze levels are checked and topped off on the equipment to keep it ready to use for the next golf season.
