Tee Block Conversion

When you come to play in the Senior Scramble for the remainder of the cool season at Bear Creek, you will find that the traditional warm season tee markers have been brought in to the maintenance building for repairs, and have been replaced by the ball-shaped markers. No markers will be placed on the warm season gold tee boxes. Black ball-shaped markers will be placed on the warm season black tee boxes. White ball-shaped markers will be placed on the warm season silver tee boxes. Green ball-shaped markers will be placed on the warm season green tee boxes. A single yellow ball-shaped marker will replace the two yellow markers from the warm season. The great majority of the warm season teeing areas will remain in use during the cool season. There are a few zoysia tee boxes that we are going to "give a rest", so that they will be healthy for the spring of 2016. These teeing areas will be replaced by nearby flat areas that have been mowed so that they will provide a quality teeing area. Please tee off between the markers on these teeing areas, and let those few zoysia tee boxes enjoy a restful cool season.
