Pond Project Update

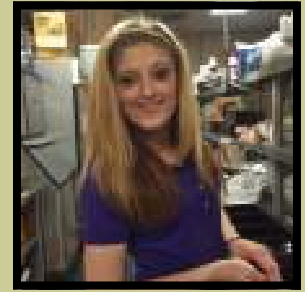
