FEATURED ARTICLE: The Crossroads for Eastern Missouri Golf

Just as Wentzville is known as the Crossroads of Mid-America, Bear Creek could be known as the Crossroads for Eastern Missouri Golf. This is particularly true of our Monday and Tuesday Senior Scrambles, where players travel from as near as the Bear Creek Subdivision and surrounding Wentzville area, to longer treks from all directions of the compass:

- From the north, down Highway 61 from Troy/other Lincoln Co. locations, and even further north into Pike Co.
- From the east, out I-70 from Lake St. Louis/Ofallon/St. Peters/St. Charles/rural Northern St. Charles Co./the Upper Highway 94 Corridor, as well as a loyal contingent from North/Northwest St. Louis Co.
- From the southeast, out I-64 from Dardenne Prairie/Cottleville/Weldon Springs/rural Southeast St. Charles Co./the Lower Highway 94 Corridor, as well as golfers from across the Daniel Boone Bridge in Chesterfield and Western St. Louis Co.
- From the south, up Highway Z and Highway T from rural Southern St. Charles/Warren Co., as well as Washington and northern Franklin Co.
- From the west, down highway 70 from Foristell/Wright City/Warrenton/rural northern Warren Co and into Montgomery Co.
