FEATURED ARTICLE: Casual Water in Sand Traps

With the frequency and quantity of rain recently, we get a lot of calls from the course on Monday/Tuesday mornings asking how to play your ball if there is water in a sand trap. The answer is: if your ball comes to rest in a sand trap and your stance or swing is affected by casual water, you are entitled to lift and clean your ball and to relief from the casual water without penalty as follows:

1. Rake and place your ball at the nearest point of relief in the sand trap, no closer to the hole.
2. If no point described in #1 above exists, rake and place your ball at the nearest point of relief in the sand trap minimally closer to the hole.
3. If no point described in #2 above exists, drop your ball at the nearest point of relief outside of the sand trap no closer to the hole.
